SUMMARY OF PROPOSED MEDICAID PAYMENT RATES

Effective January 1, 2011

Included in this document is information relating to the proposed Medicaid Payment Rates for Substance Use Disorder Service that are proposed to be effective January 1, 2011.

The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) is responsible for the reimbursement determination functions for the Texas Medicaid Program. The proposed rates were calculated in accordance with the reimbursement methodology rules in Title 1 of the Texas Administrative Code (1 TAC):

- §355.8085, which addresses the reimbursement methodology for physicians and certain other practitioners;

HHSC will conduct a public hearing to receive comments regarding the Medicaid proposed rates on November 9, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. in the Lone Star Conference Room in Building H of the Braker Center, at 11209 Metric Boulevard, Austin, TX 78758-4021, with entrance through Security at the front of the building facing Metric Boulevard. HHSC will consider concerns expressed at the hearing prior to final rate approval. This public hearing is held in compliance with the provisions of Human Resources Code §32.0282 and 1 TAC §355.105(g), which require a public hearing on proposed payment rates.
