# Proposed Medicaid Payment Rates for Targeted Case Management and Rehabilitative Services in the Mental Health program

**Effective September 1, 2011**

Included in this document is information relating to the proposed Medicaid Payment Rates for Targeted Case Management and Rehabilitative Services provided in the Mental Health program. Payment rates are proposed to be effective September 1, 2011.

The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) is responsible for the reimbursement determination functions for the Texas Medicaid Program. The proposed rates for targeted case management were calculated in accordance with the proposed reimbursement methodology rules in Title 1 of the Texas Administrative Code (TAC), §355.743 which addresses the reimbursement methodology for the Mental Health program. The proposed rates for rehabilitative services were calculated in accordance with the proposed reimbursement methodology rules in Title 1 of the TAC, §355.781 which addresses the reimbursement methodology for the Mental Health program.

HHSC will conduct a public hearing to receive comments regarding the Medicaid proposed rates on July 12, 2011, at 9:00 p.m. in the Lone Star Conference Room in Building H of the Braker Center, at 11209 Metric Boulevard, Austin, TX 78758-4021, with entrance through Security at the front of the building facing Metric Boulevard. HHSC will consider concerns expressed at the hearing prior to final rate approval. This public hearing is held in compliance with the provisions of Human Resources Code §32.0282 and 1 TAC §355.105(g), which require a public hearing on proposed payment rates.

## **BACKGROUND**

Providers of targeted case management and rehabilitative services provided in the Mental Health program are currently paid a statewide interim rate that is settled to each provider's costs within certain parameters. Effective September 1, 2011, HHSC will eliminate the current cost settlement process and implement a prospective uniform statewide reimbursement rate methodology.
